### National Crafts Museum

The National Crafts Museum is the only Japanese national art museum specialized in crafts and design objects. The museum originally opened in Tokyo in 1977, and was relocated and opened in Kanazawa in 2020. Western-style buildings from the Meiji period have been relocated and reassembled, while the galleries are newly built reinforced concrete restorations.



Kanazawa prospered as the castle town of the Maeda family of a Kaga domain, and traditional crafts such as Kaga-yuzen kimono, Kanazawa gold leaf (Kanazawa-haku), and Kutani ware, as well as traditional performing arts such as Noh and Kaga banzai, have been passed down through generations. Kanazawa is also known for its Kaga cuisine and traditional Japanese sweets (wagashi). When visiting Kanazawa, be sure to enjoy the beautiful scenery that changes with the seasons as well.
