National Crafts Museum

 $The \ National \ Crafts \ Museum \ is \ the \ only \ Japanese \ national \ art \ museum \ specialized \ in \ crafts$ and design objects. The museum originally opened in Tokyo in 1977, and was relocated and opened in Kanazawa in 2020. Western-style buildings from the Meiji period have been relocated and reassembled, while the galleries are newly built reinforced concrete restorations.


